A tenure-track appointment is available on August 1, 2019, at the rank of Assistant Professor in the Division of Business at IUPUC. The position is a ten-month teaching assignment with expectations of teaching a variety of courses across the management discipline at various academic levels, conducting and publishing quality scholarly research, and engaging in service. Strong oral and written communication skills are a must. Successful teaching at the university level is very important. Additional responsibilities include appropriate scholarship and participation in service activities at the campus.

REQUIREMENTS: ABD in a Ph.D. program in management or related field, or a Ph.D. in management or related field by December 31, 2018 and ability to teach a variety of courses in management across undergraduate and MBA levels. Area of specialization is Operations Management and Supply Chain Management.

PREFERENCES: Minimum of two years' experience in teaching traditional and non-traditional undergraduate and graduate students; applied research and business experience with clear evidence of ability to establish a successful research program; ability to bring the international dimension to content areas; ability to teach courses in Quality and/or Data Analytics; and demonstrated capacity to collaborate with faculty across disciplines. Civic engagement, grantsmanship, and/or professional experience a plus. Preference will be given to applicants who have a record of effectiveness and innovation in university level teaching and an interest in pursuing hybrid or online course delivery.
